

Naming Opportunities within Greenspun Hall

Auditorium

This 2,752 square foot auditorium seats nearly 200 people and is used for large classes, guest speakers, specialized workshops, conferences, and media festivals. The auditorium is designed to accommodate audio, visual, radio, and television production. Content produced in the auditorium can be delivered via radio, television, and the Internet.

Video Wall

This wall of high-definition video monitors provides ongoing information about our field, the outstanding professionals in our region and breaking news of local, national, and international importance. Students work with donors to produce outstanding programming that highlights the donors, interesting topics, and the professional expertise of our students.

High-definition Performance Studio

A 2,184 square feet television studio produces television content and programming for distribution via cable and the Internet. The studio features high-definition digital cameras and a flexible lighting array.

Instructional Studio

A 1,772 square feet instructional space for students in journalism, integrated marketing and emerging media. Equipment in this studio mirrors that in the larger studio to facilitate the transition from classroom to media production.

Two High-definition Editing Bays

These spaces will be used for post production of media products for clients on and off campus and for programming scheduled for cable and Internet.

Television Newsroom

This space is used by student reporters, producers, and editors to prepare stories for nightly newscasts.

Media Convergence Learning Center

Students experiment and create media content across a variety of platforms in this uniquely designed space. The lab features audio, video, radio and television production capabilities along with the most up-to-date Internet design software.

Non-linear Editing Lab

This instructional space features specialized audio, graphic and finishing programs for non-linear editing and post-production.

Writing Labs

These are instructional areas for journalism, emerging media, and integrated marketing students.

Conference Room

This meeting area is used for seminar classes, advisory board members, faculty members, and workshop participants. The space features plasma monitors, surround sound, and Internet access.

Radio Production and Performance Studios

Radio studios are used by KUNV staff and JMS students to produce audio files and radio content.

Electronic News Gathering Equipment

This equipment is used by students to collect footage for newscasts, webcasts, online audio, television programs, and integrated marketing campaigns.

Field Gathering Equipment

This equipment is used by students and UNLV TV professional staff to provide media services for the university, college and school, programming for the cable television channel and online television network and media services for the campus community.

Student Reading Room

This room is a regular gathering place for student meetings, student conferences, and library/research work.

Director's Office

This office suite is the major greeting area for all guests to the school and a regular stop for all new and returning students.

Hallway Commemorative Bricks

These bricks are placed in remembrance of our friends and alumni who support us through the collective gifts that make our school possible.
